## Practical Information

**Accommodation:** The volunteers will live in shared bedrooms with apartment common area, shared cooking, washing, laundry and social facilities, free Wi-Fi.

**Pocket and Food money:** Volunteers will receive a monthly food allowance of 150 Euro to buy food products and cook for themselves and 90 Euro as “pocket money”.

**Local Transport:** bus passes.

**Holidays:** Volunteers will work 6 hours per day, 5 days a week, two consecutive days off per week.

**Travel:** The travel costs will be reimbursed according to the distance band.
