About the project:

The main goal of training course is to presents participants with different types of games which they can use as a tool in their youth work.

We have been playing since we were children. Through the play we get to know ourselves, the world around us and we learn. Therefore, play is one of the basic forms of education and relaxation, and at the same time it can serve as an effective pedagogical tool. Social games include those games that, instead of competition, focus on social relations between people and raise the level of self-awareness and social sensibility through the element of conversation about what happened to the participants during the game.

What will we do?

- We will play a lot and learn about the power of play.
- We will get to know games which increase cooperation and trust. Learn about games which improve our communication and help us tackle various issues such as intercultural differences, discrimination....
- We will learn about group dynamics and discover what is our role in the group.
- We will share our knowledge and learn how to lead games.

INFO ABOUT TRAINERS:

Anja Mikič Crovella from Slovenia works in association Cirkus La Bulle / Association CIK. She has a master's degree in social pedagogy and is specialised in circus pedagogy. Since 2000, she has been active in the field of youth work and education of youth workers. Over the years, she has conducted various trainings in the field of alternative learning and teaching methods such as social games and circus pedagogy.

Špela Gorjan is an experienced youth worker with 20 years of experience in guiding soft skills and experiential learning based programs with youth and adults on a national as well as international level. She is a president of Youth Aid Center Association - YACA and has been an active trainer in Slovenian NA trainers pool since 2015.

THE VENUE

Metsäkartano and Rautavaara

Metsäkartano youth centre is part of a network of 9 national youth centers in Finland, supervised and subsidized by the Finnish Ministry of Education and Culture. One of the Metsäkartano's function is to develop the methods used in the field of youth work, to act as center for furthering the skills of the youth, and enable young people's travelling domestically and internationally. Metsäkartano focuses on international youth work, outdoor education and social youth work.

Metsäkartano is located in Rautavaara, a small village of 1700 inhabitants. Youth centre is 25km away from Rautavaara's centre and there's no public transport in the area. Nearest shop / pharmacy / atm and other services are located 25km away from Metsäkartano. Youth centre is by the lake, in the middle of the beautiful nature.

Traveling to Finland

Arrival 24.3.

Fix your way to Kuopio by plane/train/bus. We hope that all participants will arrive to Kuopio on 24.3. before 6 pm. We recommend green travelling.

Departure 31.3.

Try not to book early flights/trains, as our youth centre is located 1,5 hours drive away from Kuopio.

Arrivals on 24.3. The bus will pick everyone from Kuopio train station/airport/city centre around 6pm depending on your arrival times. Journey to Metsäkartano from Kuopio takes 1,5hours.

Please note, that we organize only one transfer from Kuopio to Metsäkartano on 24th of March. It means that some of you might have to wait few hours in Kuopio or Kuopio Airport, depending on your arrival times.
