process, which will contribute to their social inclusion.

During the project, we want to reveal the ability of adults with limited access to lifelong learning to adapt to digital transformation, through:

- Improving the competencies of digital facilitator

- Enhance digital transformation for 55+ years-old people

The first stage of the project is dedicated to research activities which will be the foundation to drawing up a map of the skills needed for digital facilitators to create active and engaging learning.
