Online training course and practical activity scenarios soon to be available under the SENIOR project

On May 6th 2022 in Italy took place the 3rd transnational project meeting of the strategic partnership “Supporting Elderly Needs Is Our Responsibility”, which gathered together partners from Romania – [Asociatia TEAM4Excellence](#) and [Voluntariat pentru Viață](#), Spain – [Association DESES-3](#), Poland – [INBIE](#) and Italy – [Petit Pas Aps](#). The partnership met again to keep working on increasing the level of commitment of seniors to participate in educational activities and exchanges of experiences, hosted by Petit Pas from Italy.

During this meeting we reviewed our project work. In the morning we discussed about the course modules for educators, facilitators and volunteers and the online training courses and practical activity scenarios. After lunch, among other things, we had a working group on the learning, training and teaching activity which will take place in Italy during the period 23-27 May. We planned how to design and create practical activity scenarios for supporting seniors. In addition, we had a group discussion on planning the multiplier events in the partner countries.



The coordinators presented an overview on the project results, revising the plan to transfer the project results to the target groups, which include organisations working with or training elderly, social workers, educators, facilitators, volunteers who work to support senior learners and seniors themselves.

The first project result is a [needs analysis](#) which addresses several aspects of education, from the needs of educators that work with seniors to the methods of keeping the seniors engaged in activities

The second of project result, [Supporting Elderly. A Practitioner's Guide](#), offers organisations and professionals working with seniors the possibility to improve their processes with methods developed at the European level. The Guide is available in English, Romanian, Polish, Italian and Spanish on the [Supporting Elderly Needs Is Our Responsibility](#) project website.



During the meeting, partners also discussed about the third project result “Online training course & practical activity scenarios”, which will be developed on a Moodle structure and will comprise of multimedia content for the course modules for educators in English and partners languages, educational material to maximize learner participation. Each online courses will also provide links to other useful online resources and good practices in this field of seniors’ education. Soon, the course will be available on the MOOC platform <https://courses.trainingclub.eu/>.
