HOW WE WORKED FOR THESE RESULTS?

On the 30th of June, [Osmaniye İl Milli Eğitim Müdürlüğü](#) hosted the third transnational meeting of the project BeBlue in Osmaniye, Turkey. It was an excellent opportunity to revise the BeBlue Online Training Course, and discuss and integrate the feedback from our participants. Moreover, partners agreed on the strategy of sharing the results with VET learners and mentors.

Each partner updated the dissemination plan and activity schedule, making use of the professional network established during project implementation.

The final transnational project meeting was proudly hosted on the 2nd of September by [TEAM4Excellence](#) in Constanta, Romania. Being the last meeting and celebrating the achievements of the 2-year project results, the main goal was to establish the exploitation and sustainability plan.

Therefore, partners agreed on using the Blue Career eMentoring Programme in the future to guide and attract new VET learners towards blue industry.



HOW WE SHARED OUR PROJECT RESULTS?



On the 29th of August, the [Osmaniye Provincial National Education of the Directorate](#) organised one Multiplier event attended by 20 participants from seven VET organisations and schools in Osmaniye, Turkey.

The purpose of the multiplier event was to describe the overall work done throughout the life of the project, and particularly the main project results, including the Career Map with 100 job cards, the Blue Career Online Training Course and the Blue Career eMentoring Programme. The overall idea was to make the participants aware of all these results and educational materials, as well as to provide them with practical examples on how the participants could use the results in their daily work with vocational students.



On 16 September 2022, [TEAM4Excellence](#) promoted the Blue Career Map to VET students from the [Marina High School of Constanta](#).

We handed out flyers about the BeBlue Erasmus+ project from where learners could access the Blue Career Map, 100 Job Cards and the BeBlue Training Course. During the event, VET students learned more about the career opportunities in the blue economy and gained relevant information from the job cards to help them make informed decisions. Nicoleta Acomi, pro-dean of the Maritime University of Constanta guided them towards understanding the possibilities offered by each sector of the blue economy. The participants learnt about the career paths, cross-sectoral options and how to get those jobs according to their level of training and skills.



On the 21st of September, [Osmaniye Provincial National Education of the Directorate](#) organised the Career Planning event which was attended by 23 participants from four VET organisations and schools.

At the beginning, participants were presented the Erasmus+ values and the results of the BeBlue project which aims to promote blue careers and training opportunities to increase and upskill the workforce. Students of VET organisations have built their career plans, taking into account the benefits that the blue economy brings among young people and they said that this workshop made them use their introspection and look for training opportunities towards their area of interest.



On September 29, partner organization [Sea Teach](#) organized the multiplier event in Palma, Spain, presenting the results of the BeBlue Erasmus+ project.

On this occasion, the experts presented the results of the 2-year project, including the Blue Career platform, the Blue Economy Online Training Course and the Blue e-Mentoring Program Guide. The second part of the event was dedicated to guest speakers, and the audience benefited from the experience of blue professionals who shared valuable information about skills transparency, raising awareness of cross-sector pathways.



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
