Career guidance in the blue economy

Third transnational project meeting

The third transnational meeting of the Erasmus+ Strategic Partnership "Career Guidance in Blue Economy" was held in Turkey on 30 June 2022, organised by our partners [Osmaniye İl Milli Eğitim Müdürlüğü](#).

The event was held in a hybrid mode and was physically attended by two delegates from [TEAM4Excellence](#) Association (Romania) and three delegates from [Osmaniye İl Milli Eğitim Müdürlüğü](#) Association (Turkey) and one delegate from [Sea Teach](#) Association (Spain) participated online. Each partner selected participants from their own staff based on their involvement in management and financial activities and in coordinating project results.

The meeting marked the completion of [the online training course](#) "Career Guidance in the Blue Economy" and was a good opportunity for partners to review progress and goals achieved.



The first part of the meeting was dedicated to analysing the results of the piloting period of the online training course on the blue economy. Partners discussed the integration of feedback into the online course before publishing the final version of the course.

In the second part of the meeting, the partners agreed on the detailed requirements to create the Blue Career eMentoring programme proposed by TEAM4Excellence to be later integrated into the Moodle platform.

It covered the development stages, various technical aspects of enrolling VET teachers and mentors, blue professionals and VET learners, as well as piloting the programme and developing the guide. Each partner identified and invited professionals to mentor the next generation of blue economy workers.



The partners discussed the mentoring program and the tools that will be used in the mentoring platform and their confidentiality. They agreed to pilot the mentoring system physically first to validate the usefulness of the documents for further integration into the e-Mentoring programme.

In the end, the discussion topics focused on the dissemination strategy of the project and sharing the results with more youth workers and young people for the sustainability of the project.
