OUR GOALS

“The Learning Age” aims to improve the digital competencies of senior adults to facilitate the use of digital tools and applications in order to make them participate in society in a more active way.

In addition, the project also aims at sensitizing young adults about ageism and getting to know certain life and work experiences that can help them out of their unemployment problems. Indeed, the Age project will increase the scope of adult education centers, with innovative strategies that invite participation in training based on the methodology of intergenerational learning.



THE NEWS

Intergenerational learning to commit together as citizens of the XXI century KA220-ADU - Cooperation partnerships in adult education is a project co-funded by the Erasmus+ Programme of the European Union. The project started with a kick-off meeting in Valladolid (Spain) in May 2022.

The second project partner meeting in person were organized in Warsaw (Poland) in October 2022. During the meeting, the project team planned the pilot test of the almost finished "Learn to Learn" platform with educators of national adult centers, and discussed the creation and delivery of the training for young adults, the same that will be taking part and facilitating intergenerational encounters with local seniors during 2023.
