

Transport in Athens

The Metro Station, which is directly connected from the airport to the city center, is a fast way to navigate through Athens. Trains run every 30 minutes, 7 days a week from 6:30 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. If the Metro is your choice to wander around the city, keep in mind that it has a separate ticket for airport transportation, which costs 10€.

Travelling by Express Bus is an option, with four different routes that arrive at the airport 24 hours a day, seven days a week. The ticket costs 6€ and gives you access to these buses and their routes.

X93: Kifissos KTEL (long-distance buses) Station – Airport

X95: Syntagma – Airport

X96: Port of Piraeus – Airport


X97: Eliniko Metro Station – Airport

The Suburban Railway, usually mentioned as Proastiakos, connects the Airport with the port of Piraeus, along with the Athens Central Station.

Moving around Athens with public transportation requires the Athena ticket. This ticket has a variety of products to choose from and it can be bought from and recharged at all Athens transport ticket offices as well as automatic ticket issuing machines.

An example of route to the hotel/course venue:

From the Airport, take M3 to Syntagma, then take A2 to Ephesou



The City Center

The heart of Athens beats from Syntagma Square to Monastiraki and the areas surrounding them. The streets are always filled with life and while walking in those districts, you can take part in the Greek daily routine. Small taverns with live music, cafeterias and bars offer you many opportunities to experience the renowned Greek hospitality. In the near vicinity, there are many archaeological places to enjoy, such as the Acropolis and Plaka.
