## Citizen Media into daily youth work

## **Multiplier Event**

On the 29th of September, <u>TEAM4Excellence Association</u> had the pleasure to welcome more than 35 guests to the multiplier event of <u>Citizen Media</u> Erasmus+ project at <u>Constanta Maritime</u> <u>University</u>. The aim of the event was to share our CiMe project results together with our European Solidarity Corps volunteers. The main objective was increasing the awareness of youth and youth workers about the new educational materials available in the area of digital citizenship.

The event started at 17 with a presentation of the intellectual outputs one by one, highlighting how they can be used in youth work. Although the event gathered 35 participants made up of teachers, youth workers and representatives of educational institutions and NGOs from Constanta, the CiMe project was also disseminated to a large number of underage students by our ESC volunteers. At the same time, Nicoleta Acomi from TEAM4Excellence presented the Erasmus+ programme and the CiMe Strategic partnership for the teachers and youth workers.



Additionally, the presentation of our project results explained how to integrate the materials into youth work, including three specific areas: <u>E-tutorials</u>, exploring the online learning environment in the context of the <u>Learning Management System and Assessment</u> and the <u>CiMe magazine</u>.

Afterwards, we invited the participants to a group activity to use the information from the etutorials developed within the project. First, we formed 5 groups and they had to watch the etutorial relevant to your group's theme (Storytelling, Fake News, Online Security, Content Creation, or Social Media). They had to discuss the key messages from the e-tutorial and develop real-life scenarios based on their theme. They used brainstorming to create the





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scenarios with the entire group. At the end, they had to present their conclusions in front of the other groups.



At the end, teachers asked us to organize workshops with their students about digital citizenship. These workshops will focus on topics of interest promoted in CiMe materials. ESC volunteers and TEAM4Excellence staff will go to schools to facilitate these workshops following new partnerships with educational institutions in Constanta, Romania.
